

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Michael James Webb and Barbara Jean Webb** are authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at 28 Cottle Hill Drive, Kerikeri, and known as **Cottle Hill Winery**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day. **However**, a person may sell or deliver grape wine or fruit wine on Easter Sunday if the grape wine or fruit wine is made –
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 9.00 pm
- (c) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises, situated at 28 Cottle Hill Drive, Kerikeri, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Far North District Licensing Committee on 22nd of October 1996.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance into the **tasting room** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) **either** -
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; **or**
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; **but**
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, **either**-
 - i. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; **or**
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
